

VQHA STATE QUALIFYING CRITERIA
for the
2018 AQHA NOVICE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

***** Qualifying Period – Parallel to AQHA’s decision (1/1/2017 – 12/31/2017) *****

1. All Novice Youth and Novice Amateur’s will earn state affiliate show points at any VQHA approved show.
2. They must be a member in good standing of AQHA and VQHA will tally the total points for each exhibitor in each of their classes shown.
3. VQHA will submit the top 3 point earning exhibitors in each of the novice disciplines being held at the Championship Show.
4. Points are compiled on one horse, one exhibitor basis.
5. Must have a minimum of 15 state points and/or show in five shows to be eligible. .

State Points are awarded based on the number of horses in the class and the exhibitor placing. The max points earned in one class is 9. Listed below is how state points are awarded.
